
**Minutes**  
**Special Called Council Meeting**

The Governing Body of the City of Maud will hold a Special Called Council Meeting on March 20, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 135 Main St., Maud, Texas, for consideration of the following agenda items:

1. Call meeting to order, roll call, establish a quorum.  
*Meeting called to order at 2:02pm. All members present except Councilman Wayne Foster. A quorum was established.*
2. Invocation and pledge of allegiance.  
*Mayor Pro Tem voiced the prayer and the group led the pledge.*
3. Consider and take official action accepting one of the three quotes for a lease purchase excavator.  
**QUOTE 1:** From Ledwell Machinery, E35 25HP R2-Series Bobcat Compact Excavator. Key-start and on site, with an estimated monthly lease payment of \$1,020.33.  
**QUOTE 2:** From Ledwell Machinery, E35 25HP R2-Series Bobcat Compact Excavator. Keyless-start, with an estimated monthly lease payment of \$1,477.44.  
**QUOTE 3:** From River Valley Tractor, U35-4R3A Kubota excavator with rubber tracks with the prepaid maintenance and extended warranty. The estimated monthly lease payment of \$1,865.10. Without the prepaid maintenance and extended warranty. The estimated monthly lease payment would be \$1,706.80  
*Motion by Councilman Boyd Sartin and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilman Herman Sewell to accept quote # 1 for the machine from Ledwell machinery with the key start. Motion carried with no opposition.*
