
Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Monday, April 20, 2026 @ 6:00 p.m.

The Governing Body of the City of Maud will hold a Regular Council Meeting on April 20, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. preceded by a workshop at 5:30 pm, in the Council Chambers located at 135 Main St., Maud, Texas, for consideration of the following agenda items:

1. Call meeting to order, roll call, establish a quorum.
Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm. All council members were preset and a quorum was established.
2. Invocation and pledge of allegiance.
Mayor Pro Tem, Linda Price, called on City Secretary, Vicki May, to voice the prayer. The group led the pledge.
3. Consider and take official action on approving the Consent Agenda – all items are deemed to require minimal council deliberation and can be enacted as one business item.
 - a. March 2026 financials;
 - b. March 20, 2026 Special called meeting minutes;
 - c. March 2026 Departmental Reports- Library-Savannah Monroe;
Fire Department-Chief Shane Smith; Code Enforcement-Brett Kenward.
Some questions were asked regarding the trial balance totals. Budget Finance Director, Kindall Smith, answered what she could and advised council that the other questions would have to be confirmed with different reports that she would have to pull from the accounting software. She will reach out within the week to answer their questions. Motion by Councilman Boyd Sartin and 2nd by Herman Sewell to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried with no opposition.
4. Consider and approve Resolution 26-0420. A resolution authorizing the appointment of a representative to serve as a director on the Ark-Tex Council of Governments (ATCOG) board of directors.
Motion by Councilman Boyd Sartin and 2nd by Councilman Jeffery Crawford to approve Resolution 26-0420 appointing John Nichols to the ATCOG board as Maud's representative. Motion carried with no opposition.
5. Consider and take official action approving Ordinance 26-0420. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAUD, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE 2021-0119. AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGER. CALLING FOR THE ABOLISHMENT OF THE POSITION, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.
Motion by Councilman Jeffery Crawford and 2nd by Councilman Boyd Sartin to approve Ordinance 26-0420. Motion carried with no opposition.


6. Consider and take official action to allow up to \$4,000.00 to be spent to stock the shop with needed power tools and supplies.
Councilman Herman Sewell made a motion to approve the purchase of tools needed to do assigned jobs with the stipulation that all city owned tools be inventoried checked out for use. Councilman Boyd Sartin 2nd the motion. Motion carried with no opposition.
7. Consider and take official action to partner with Bowie County to install, grade and blade 2" overlay on city streets to be determined by need.
Motion was made by Councilman Jeffery Crawford and 2nd by Councilman Herman Sewell to approve the partnership with Bowie County for city street maintenance. Councilman Boyd Sartin made the request that the city be involved along with the county official, in the determination process of the streets to be repaired. Motion carried with no opposition.
8. Mayor Pro Tem and Council to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to GC §551.072.
Deliberation regarding Real Property.
Mayor Pro Tem and council adjourned to executive session at 6:55pm. Councilman Boyd Sartin requested that Budget/Finance Director to join the closed session.
9. Mayor Pro Tem and Council to reconvene to open session pursuant to GC §551.072.
Deliberation regarding Real Property.
Mayor Pro Tem and council reconvened into open session at 7:20 pm. Councilman Boyd Sartin made a motion to give bid authority to John Nichols to bid on real property within the city limits with an undisclosed bid ceiling due to the competitive bidding process. Motion was 2nd by Councilman Herman Sewell. Motion carried with no opposition.
10. Adjourn.
Motion by Councilman Boyd Sartin and 2nd by Councilman Jeffery Crawfords to adjourn. Motion carried with no opposition.
